

Home Group Questions 21st & 22nd May – Romans 6:1-23

1. All Christians know they should not sin. Why then do we find it so hard to obey God?
2. How would you summarise what **vs 2-10** say about what has happened to every believer in the Lord Jesus and God's intention for every believer? (**see also vs11-13**)
3. Why does Paul keep saying **Do you not know?** (v3,v16) Why is knowing who you are and what has happened to you as a Christian so important?
4. In seeking to live as a Christian, how conscious are you of being united to Christ?
5. **Vs 15-23** speak of slavery and freedom. What different kinds of slavery and freedom do you find here? How easy from your own experience do you find to relate to these different slaveries and freedoms of which Paul speaks?
6. How did these Roman Christians move from being slaves to sin to being slaves of righteousness and of God? (**vs17-18**) In what way might that be an encouragement to us?
7. How does this chapter show us that in Christ we are free to offer ourselves to God and what incentives does it give us to actually offer ourselves again and again? How might we encourage one another with these truths and incentives?
