Inshes East Prayer Topics for 10th April

You have made known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand. (Psalm 16:11)

1. Taiwan: pray for the people in the aftermath of the earthquake last week. Give thanks for the swift and effective emergency response. Remember the ongoing efforts to rescue people still trapped in the mountainous regions.

2. Haiti: pray for peace & provision and in the midst of an escalating humanitarian crisis as gang violence spirals in the country. Over 5 million people in need of humanitarian aid (more info <u>here</u> & <u>here</u>) pray also for restabilising of law & order

3. Kathleeen Burns – continue to pray for her future and her desire to serve the Lord. Pray for wisdom as she seeks God's will to be involved in mission in Edinburgh. Pray also for the times she returns to Ireland to relieve her sister caring for their mum and for her witness to the family.

4. SU Camps: pray for the camps taking place this week in Gowan Bank, Lendrick Muir, Scoughall and Alltnacriche.

5. MOL: pray for deepening relationships with the parents at **Tiny Talk** (18th) & for new parents to come along; pray for clarity & unity as we continue to **develop a vision** for the church & gather a core team

6. Families & Youth Worker – continue in prayer as we seek God's guidance and provision for this post.

7. Pray for Holiday Truth Trackers & leaders (14th); Busy Hands (15th); LBS & Girls' Brigade (16th); FAB (17th)

8. CARE: Jesus our Healer, we pray for medical professionals, the majority of whom oppose assisted suicide as it undermines trust between doctor and patient, causes conflict with colleagues, and changes the ethos of medicine; to 'do no harm'. In Your mercy. Amen.
