- 7. CARE:** *Lord, please give those working in GCHQ the information skills and determination they need especially in crisis situations to identify disrupt and security challenges and terrorist plots that threaten life, stability and peace. Lead them for Christ's sake. Amen*

- 5) for a leader, locally or nationally having to make difficult & important decisions
- 6) for someone in another church family that you know- for their encouragement, their witness
- 7) for someone whose job or financial security is threatened by the current situation
