Show the wonder of your great love, you who save by your right hand those who take refuge in you from their foes. (Psalm 17:7)

- **2 India:** As national elections take place 14th Apr-Jun 1st & result announced on June 4th, pray they may be fair & whatever outcome, religious freedom would be preserved (see here & here & here)
- **3. David Moore:** Given thanks & pray for those who attended Palm Sunday service (around 50) & especially those who took a copy of Mark's gospel, for ongoing relationships & gospel conversations.
- **4. Caroline White:** "Life has been very busy since I got back. Board meeting went well & school has restarted properly today after a slow start due to Ramadan and Eid holidays for most of last week. Please continue to remember **Dr James'** visa reapplication; something seems to be moving." Pray.
