1. Pray for the families of 920 people killed in earthquake in **Afghanistan with 600 wounded**. Resources were stretched before this. Pray help would get to those who need it most. Continue to pray for Christians in A for whom life remains increasingly dangerous because of their faith.
2. Every Sunday churches in **Ukraine** are full of seekers. Pray many may be brought to repentance, faith and hope in Christ. Pray for the **Donbas region** now the crucible of the conflict where towns are being destroyed & many people are dying each day. Continue to pray for an end to the war.
- 3.. **Glasgow Presbytery's Mission Plan** will put **Sandyford, St George's Tron, St Rollox & St Andrew's West &** pioneer ministries in **Toryglen, Ruchazie & Wallacewell** in one 'cluster' w 3 Ministers or mission workers allocated to it – pray for these churches as they discuss how to make this work

5. Pray for end of year Assemblies at **Drakies PS** (Fri 24<sup>th</sup>) and **Inshes PS** (Mon 27<sup>th</sup>) with David & Cleopas participating.
6. With **All Age Presentation Gathering** this Sunday, pray for leaders, young people & children of **IT, Truthtrackers & Creche** giving thanks for all that's been learnt & enjoyed & praying that seed of God's Word continues to grow & bear fruit in precious young lives. 7. **CARE: Lord, please bless those who are refugees settling into communities throughout the UK. We pray for neighbours & local churches to welcome & help those facing uncertainty. By Your grace.**
