

### Inshes East Prayer Topics for 23<sup>rd</sup> April

*Jesus said (to Mary Magdalene), "Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet returned to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, 'I am returning to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" (John 20:17)*

**1. Roman Catholic Church:** As people mourn the loss of **Pope Francis**, pray for the Cardinals who will begin meeting soon to elect a new Pope. Pray for someone committed to upholding biblical truth.

**2. Drs James & Andrene Hayton:** Give thanks for Holy Week & Easter services & celebrations held in hospital chapel & compound. Pray these bear fruit in lives of those there & in witness to others in local community; & pray too for many malnourished babies & toddlers coming to hospital for help. Continue to remember **Caroline White** seeking God's will for her future.

**3. Mayhews:** Pray for fruit from recent children's **Easter Club**. Give thanks for 30-45 people coming regularly to church at **Provins** on Sundays at bowling alley & for opportunities to witness locally. Pray as seek to build relationship with local mayor & see how they can serve in local community.

**4. Highland International Church** are enjoying meeting on Sundays in **Raigmore Community Centre**. Give thanks for 4 people joining church last Sunday by profession of faith. Pray for ongoing witness.

**5. UHI CU:** Pray for those from Wednesday **Badminton Club** who heard gospel at recent Christians in Sport Quiz night. Remember CU meetings on Monday evenings **Apr 28<sup>th</sup> & May 12<sup>th</sup>**
