

Inshes Prayer Topics for 23rd November 2022

Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? (Psalm 85:6)

- 1. COP27:** Give thanks African concerns were heard; there's been a complete turnaround in policy from Brazil; & a fund is to be set up for loss and damage for those nations most affected by global warming. Pray for progress and complete implementation of these agreements.
- 2. Qatar:** Pray God would be at work during World Cup, building his church, esp encouraging local Qatari believers facing many restrictions & difficulties because of their faith. Pray for witness during World Cup & that world attention might result in greater religious freedom for Qataris (see [here](#))
- 3. West Smethwick (Martins):** Give thanks for **H**, who came to UK for asylum, came to faith in Jesus & was baptised last Sunday. Pray for him to grow in faith; & also for his wife & 2 children. Pray too for door-to-door visits inviting people to services especially Carol service on Dec 18th.
- 4.** Pray for **FAB** toddler & babies group meeting every Wed & **Who let the Dads Out** Sat (26th) morn.
- 5.** Pray for the **Service for Remembering** this Sunday at 3pm. Pray also for invitations going out this week round MOL for **Christmas Community Carols** at MOL Primary School on Sun 4th December
- 6.** Pray for **Christmas Presentations** in church building to **P4** classes for **Inshes PS** (Thur 1st) **Drakies PS** (Tues 6th) & **MOL PS** (Thurs 8th) - as well as Assembly at **Inshes PS** (Fri 2nd)
- 7. CARE:** *Lord of the Church, please continue to inspire, equip & bless Christian initiatives that reach out with Your loving care to people in need; through foodbanks, debt advice, help for the homeless, youth & children's activities, relationship support & other services. In Your mercy. Amen*
