- 2. Olympic Games:** All 50 countries on the Open Doors' World Watch List are participating (see [here](#)). Pray for Refugee Team, people with no home state. Pray for all of the world's Christians displaced by violence and conflict. Ask God to give comfort to the refugees, that they would know Him and His peace
- 3.** Pray for **Susan Gnadou-Zabo** preparing for **GBU summer camp in August** which will mark end of her time with GBU & for guidance for future for herself **Guy-Steevy & Adriel**
- 4.** Pray for **Mayhews** - give thanks for new home in Saint Loup de Naud & opportunity to share Christ with neighbour; Excellent start to Provins youth group, 17 came. Pray for the provision of sustainable premises to use as a place of worship
- 5. Caroline White:** give thanks for granted visa. Pray for grace & peace during recent unexpected change of plans resulting in **CW** & the **Haytons** not able to work on compound for the time being
- 6. Southport** – pray God's comfort and peace will be keenly felt by **the families** in their sorrow and as they grieve the loss of young lives. Pray too for those in hospital and the police as they seek to restore order in the community
- 7. Fit for a King Holiday Club:** give thanks for those signed up to come & pray for all practical preparations. Continue to pray for **Christian Camps & Holiday Clubs**
- 8. CARE:** *Lord, we pray for ongoing success with the growing number of restoration initiatives to reverse growing serious damage to coral reefs that shelter thousands of sea animals.
